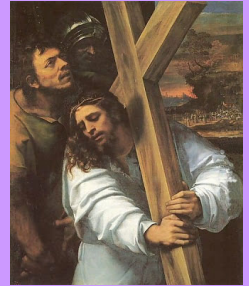

Here we are. Another Lenten season is upon us. This is the year I'm going to make it all 6 weeks. I'm going to give up Coke and candy bars. I'm going to fast on Fridays, and I'm going to pray in the morning before work/school. I'm committed. (By the way, how are your New Year's resolutions going?)

Don't worry! We've all been there. Every year. All you have to do is try. All you have to do is try each day. Then, when you forget and eat something you shouldn't have, or didn't pray in the morning, just start over the next day. The biggest thing is to NOT GIVE UP.

Ask God for help this Lent. Ask him to walk with you, to guide you, to strengthen you. Then do your part - One. Day. At. A. Time. - and be sure to pray, fast and give. (Have you made your pledge to the Bishop's Annual Appeal?)

22% of the money collected through the BAA is distributed by CATHOLIC CHARITIES. They provide help and create hope for our neighbors in need through the Disaster Services, Family Crisis Support, Food Pantries, and Immigration Services programs. Last year over 58,000 individuals were assisted, and over 3-million pounds of food were distributed. For example, the BAA gives a parishioner in Wilmington the ability to help a struggling family in Roxboro receive food assistance. A gift to the BAA means a family in Raleigh helps pay for the books of a young man studying for the priesthood. The BAA enables a life-long Catholic in Hillsborough to share the Gospel with a curious young adult on a college campus in Greenville. A gift to the BAA enables a parishioner on the Outer Banks to provide medicine for a Farmworker in Newton Grove. These are just a few examples of the far-reaching impact of the diocesan Bishop's Annual Appeal.

Thank you for your continued support of the Bishop's Annual Appeal. The goal, this year, for Immaculate Conception is \$20,300 and our pledges have already reached half our goal. Please continue to complete pledge cards and drop them in the mail or bring them to the church office.
