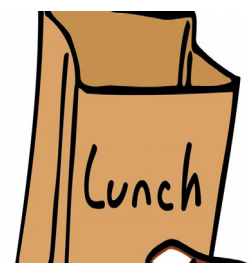

Holy Father Pope Francis recently announced a two-year process of preparation for the **2023 XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops**, under the guiding title, “**For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission.**”

This synodal process will involve a broad consultation and dialogue among the faithful throughout the world over three phases:

1. In each local diocese discussions and reflections will be compiled into a summary document by April 2022.
2. Next, within nations or regions, the discussions within dioceses in that nation or region may be further compiled into a working document.
3. Working documents submitted to Rome will be used during discussions in the universal phase of the process, at the synod itself in 2023.

The Diocese of Raleigh will begin its synod journey this Sunday with prayer: “For the Church, gathered in synod, that by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, this journey may be marked by humble listening, courageous speech and lively hope. We pray to the Lord...”

More details will be following. As we begin to structure further how the synodal process in our diocese will occur over the next several months, please also continue to pray the synod prayer below in support of these local and global efforts.

Inicio de la Participación Diocesana en los Preparativos para el Sínodo Mundial 2023

Como ustedes saben, nuestro Santo Padre el Papa Francisco, inauguró este pasado sábado, en Roma, un proceso preparatorio de dos años para la **XVI Asamblea General Ordinaria del Sínodo de los Obispos 2023**, cuyo título es “**Por una Iglesia sinodal: comunión, participación y misión**”. Si bien el término “sínodo” no es familiar para la mayoría de los católicos, tiene sus raíces en griego, lo que significa “caminar con” o “caminar juntos”. A lo largo de nuestra historia como católicos, se han convocado sínodos para caminar unos con otros en el Espíritu Santo, para escuchar y discernir cómo la Iglesia está siendo llamada en comunión, para responder con fe y participar en la obra del Evangelio y en la misión que Nuestro Señor, nos ha confiado como Pueblo de Dios.

El objetivo de este proceso sinodal actual es favorecer un amplio proceso de consulta y diálogo entre los fieles en todo el mundo en tres fases: 1) en cada diócesis local, donde las discusiones y reflexiones se resumirán en un documento en abril de 2022, 2) seguido de la siguiente fase dentro de las naciones o regiones, donde las discusiones dentro de las diócesis de esa nación o región, se puedan recoger en un documento de trabajo, 3) y luego presentar estas experiencias durante las discusiones en la fase universal del proceso, en el propio Sínodo en Roma en 2023.

Más adelante compartiremos más detalles, a medida que comencemos a ampliar la estructura del proceso sinodal en nuestra Diócesis durante los próximos meses. Sepan de mi gratitud por su apoyo a los fieles en este gran esfuerzo. Que el Espíritu Santo nos guíe y nuestra Señora de la Inmaculada Concepción, patrona de nuestra diócesis, vele por nosotros mientras caminamos juntos en la fe, a lo largo de este proceso y siempre.

dispón nuestros corazones a la escucha.

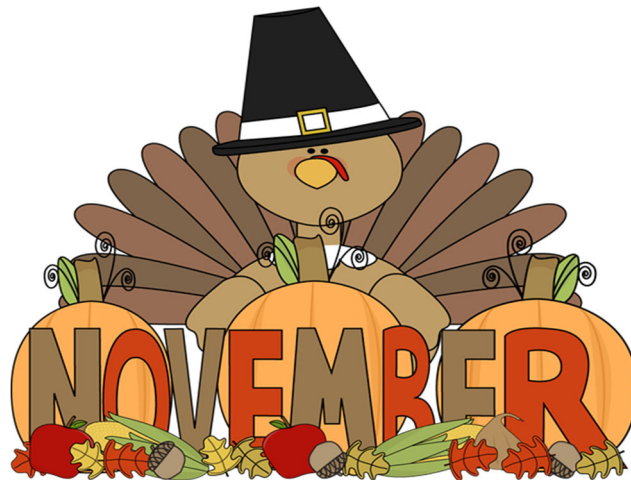
Ven, Espíritu de santidad,

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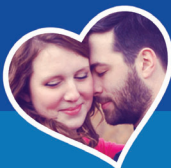


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
